

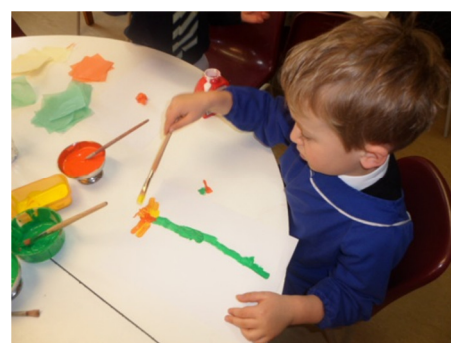
## Let's make pizza!
